P/14/81	APOLOGIES Apologies were received from Cllrs Ezra and Clark.	
P/14/82	DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST There were no declarations of interest.	
P/14/83	MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING The minutes of the previous meeting held 4 th September were agreed and signed by the Chairman. The Chairman reported that AVALC were collating views and concerns of parishes regarding the changes to the way planning matters are communicated with parish and town councils. Cllr Sue Polhill, Lead for Planning at AVDC, would be writing to all parish councils regarding the decision.

P/14/88	14/02718/APP – 9 EDWARD CLOSE, AYLESBURY – single storey side and rear extension This application was discussed and NO OBJECTIONS were raised.	
P/14/89	DECISIONS ON PLANNING APPLICATIONS RECEIVED 14/02025/APP – Community Centre, Eskdale Road – Provision of new external door and internal alterations. PERMITTED 14/01112/APP – 2 Risborough Road, Stoke Mandeville – The Chairman attended AVDC Development Management Committee to speak to the Parish Council's objection to the application. The decision was delegated back to officers to make once the issues surrounding access to the site had been resolved.
