	Brook Close/Road or Drive - to acknowledge the nearby Stoke Brook which runs behind the site	
	Patron Close/Road/Drive - in recognition of the Queen's 90 <sup>th</sup> birthday year

	Cllr Clark said that comments had been made to him recently regarding the Parish Council's decision to raise no objections to the application for Hampden Fields.
