If you contact us online, your information will be processed by the Parish Council with the utmost care. We are registered as data controllers with the Information Commissioner's Office and all data is collected and processed in adherence with the Data Protection Act (1998).

Stoke Mandeville Parish Council will only use the information we hold for the purposes it was obtained.

We will not share your personal information with any third parties without your knowledge.

Analytical Tracking & Cookies

Stoke Mandeville Parish Council recognises the importance of assessing website usage trends to gauge priorities.

To this end, we make use of Google Analytics which makes a non-invasive record of domain traffic. It does not collect personal or private data about you or your computer.

By browsing the Stoke Mandeville Parish Council website you are giving consent for the Google Analytics software to set a cookie on your computer.
